Montagne-Saint-Émilion

ESTATE

Château Tour Bayard is a recent addition to the Milhade portfolio, coming into the family through marriage. This 25 acre property in the St.-Émilion satellite Montagne-St.-Émilion has been run by the Richard family since 1956, and is now regarded as one of the top estates in the appellation.

WINE

Tour Bayard is relatively modern in style, with refined tannins, punchy fruit, and seductive aromas enhanced by malolactic fermentation in barrique.

VINEYARD

Soils: The soils here are a mix of clay and limestone marl, and the vineyard is planted in a beautifully situated natural amphitheater with an ideal southerly exposure. Merlot is the predominant variety, accounting for 85% of the wine, complemented by Cabernet Franc; the vines are about 40 years old on average. The Richard family works the soils organically, eschewing pesticides and other chemical treatments. The Malbec is generally bottled as a separate cuvée.

Grape Varieties: 85% Merlot, 15% Cabernet Franc

WINEMAKING

Fermentation: At harvest, the grapes are 100% destemmed and crushed before being placed in temperature controlled vats. Each parcel on the estate is vinified separately, and the wine is raised for 12 months in a combination of cement tanks (60%) and new and second fill barrels (20% each). The finished wine is supple and full-bodied, with excellent ripeness, and refined aromatics from the Cabernet Franc.

Aging: combination of cement vats and first and second use barriques for 12 months.

VINTAGE

2015 was an exceptional vintage throughout Bordeaux, with a hot summer followed by a long, cool autumn. The wines are uniformly ripe round, with exceptionally polished tannins covered buried by the ripe fruit. Although the wines are clearly well-structured, their concentration and fruit intensity make them appealing quite early. The 2015 is a watershed vintage for Tour Bayard, with masses of blue fruits framed by touches of vanilla and spice. The wine was expressive upon release, and will continue to improve as it ages. The 2015 establishes Tour Bayard as the clear quality leader in Montagne.



TASTING NOTE

The wine offers flavors of cacao, black fruits, and spice, framed by significant structure and capped by a seductively long finish.
